WAYS TO VOTE

ABSENTEE/VOTE BY MAIL

The deadline to request an
absentee ballot was September
30th, BUT, if you do have an
absentee ballot, you can mail it
back or drop it at an official
drop box.

**IMPORTANT: be sure to
follow all directions
carefully when filling in the
paper ballot so your vote
will be cast successfully!**

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

"The earlier the better" might be
our favorite motto. Many polling
places are open Monday through
Saturday during the early voting
period, and you can choose which
location is most convenient to you
(as opposed to your assigned
location on Election Day).

ELECTION DAY IN-PERSON VOTING

Always an option, but plan to
potentially spend the day at the
polls. Make sure to bring a
chair, water, and some snacks.
Many volunteers will be out
helping to feed and encourage
those who have to wait!
